

The Unitek Learning Online Library Brookline, Eagle Gate College, Provo College, Unitek College

The online library is accessible to students on a 24 hour, and 7 days a week schedule. Students can access library services via Moodle. A librarian, with an MLS from an American Library Association accredited program provides support for all students and faculty. Students can submit questions to <u>library@unitekcollege.edu</u>. Personnel will respond within 48 (during the week) to 72 (over the weekend) hours from contact. Students evaluate library services in course evaluations. To ensure the library is meeting students and faculty needs, both are surveyed during the course evaluations or reviews.

The faculty have helped review electronic resources and made recommendations to the librarian for acquisition of additional electronic journals. Currently the students have access to LIRN collection of databases and the OVID nursing Journals database. The access passwords and log in information is provided in all syllabi and available on the Pages tab under Library Resources of each course in the Moodle LMS.

The LIRN collection can be reached either by first logging into Moodle and selecting the Online Library tab, or at http://proxy.lirn.net. All library resources are available on campus and off-site to students and faculty. These resource tools provide current scholarly articles and information in all academic subject areas. The library has additional access information for students. Computers, references, and periodicals are available in the library and other dedicated rooms.

OVID research materials are available and include nursing journals. Access to OVID Nursing journals is available through <u>https://tools.ovid.com/lpcms/?Unitek</u> Databases are available 24/7 from any computer with Internet access and a login code provided by the college.
